E-cigarettes and vaping are covered in our Health curriculum at Skyline as well. Students seem regularly to be surprised by how harmful e-cigarettes are. Just like drugs, alcohol and cigarettes, e-cigarettes are not allowed on ISD property at all. This is covered in our student handbook (located at our school website).

Tobacco - Tobacco products and delivery devices include, but are not limited to, cigarettes, cigars, snuff, smoking tobacco, smokeless tobacco, nicotine, electronic smoking/vapor devices and vapor products, non-prescribed inhalers, nicotine delivery devices or chemicals that are not FDA-approved to help people quit using tobacco, devices that produce the same flavor or physical effect of nicotine substances and any other smoking equipment, device, material or innovation. Any use of such products and delivery devices by staff, students, visitors and community members will be prohibited on all District property, including all District buildings, grounds and district-owned vehicles, and within five hundred feet of schools. Possession by or distribution of tobacco products to minors is prohibited. TOBACCO PRODUCTS- Tobacco products include but are not limited to cigarettes, cigars, snuff, smoking tobacco, smokeless tobacco, nicotine, nicotine delivering devices, chemicals or devices that produce the same flavor or physical effect of nicotine substances; and any other tobacco innovation per ISD Regulation 4215.
