

# Kindergarten Timeline 2018

## March

Registration is required

March 9: Kindergarten Registration due

Pre-K Assessment for your child in March or April

- Your school will contact you
- You go with your child to the assessment
- The assessment is reading (letters, sounds and a few words)

## July

Pre-K Summer school is by invitation

July 9 -August 3

If you are invited:

Pre-K Summer School (sponsored by *Issaquah Schools Foundation*)

- Focus on reading skills and introduction to school
- Free transportation
- Prepares students for Kindergarten

Bus ride and  
"Ready for School Fair"  
are optional

August 10 (morning or afternoon enrollment help)

"Ready for School" Fair (help with Online Verification)—Optional

10 am to noon at Maywood Middle School Library
